

# ISA MIDKON 2026

## Paper Presentation Guidelines

### General Submission Eligibility

- **Registration for ISA MIDKON 2026:** Mandatory for the presenting author.
- **Membership:** The presenting author is required to be a **Life Member/Associate Life Member** of the ISA.
- **Originality:** The work must be **original research** and should not have been previously published or accepted for publication/presentation elsewhere.
- **Presenting Author:** The **first author** is typically the presenting author.

**The abstract (not to exceed 250 words) shall contain the following headings**

1. Title
2. Introduction
3. Methodology
4. Results: One most relevant table/ image/graph/illustration
5. Discussion
6. Conclusion
7. References (Two, most relevant)

- Last date for submission of abstracts is strictly **31<sup>st</sup> January 2026**
- No further requests will be entertained

### **Presentation Format (Oral Paper)**

The presentation is usually a **Microsoft PowerPoint** file, adhering to a strict time and slide limit.

Aspect	Guidelines
Total Time Allotted	<b>6 minutes</b> (4 minutes for presentation, 2 minutes for Q&A)
Format	<b>Microsoft PowerPoint</b> only (no videos or animations are typically allowed).
Slide Count	<b>Minimum 5, Maximum 10 slides</b> , excluding the title and reference slides.
Slide Ratio	<b>16:9</b> (Widescreen) is the standard aspect ratio.
Content per Slide	Maximum of <b>10 lines of text</b> per slide to ensure readability.

## Standard Content Structure

Your presentation slides should strictly follow a scientific structure to maximize clarity within the time limit.

Section	Recommended Slides & Content
1. Title Slide	(1 slide): Title, Presenting Author's Name, Co-Authors, Affiliation/Institution, ISA Logo, and Institutional Logo.
2. Introduction	(1 slide): Background, <b>Need for the study</b> , and <b>Aims &amp; Objectives</b> (Clearly define your research question).
3. Methodology	(2-3 slides): <b>Type and design</b> of the study, Ethical clearance/Trial registration (if applicable), Study location and population, <b>Inclusion/Exclusion criteria</b> , <b>Sample size</b> estimation, Interventions/Parameters studied, and <b>Statistical analysis</b> details.
4. Results	(2-3 slides): <b>Details of demographics</b> , Presentation of <b>Primary and Secondary outcome measures</b> . Use <b>suitable illustrations</b> (tables, graphs, or flowcharts) to depict key findings. <i>Do not repeat values already presented in tables/figures.</i>
5. Discussion	
6. Conclusion	
7. References	

### Key Cautions

- **Avoid Plagiarism:** Submissions typically undergo a plagiarism check (often < 25% similarity index is allowed).
- **Professionalism:** Maintain a **balanced view** of therapeutic options; use **generic names** for drugs where possible.
- **Proofread:** Ensure all slides and the abstract are free of errors.
